4. About the TMD

This Target Market Determination (TMD) document is not intended to provide financial advice. Please refer to our Terms and Conditions and Credit Guide before deciding product suitability. Our product terms and conditions will be provided to you upon request.

This TMD aims to provide an understanding of the class of customers we have designed this product for, being the target market. When considering the target market, we focused on our customers' objectives, financial situation, and needs within this class of people we believe this product to be suitable.

5. Target Market

5.1 Description of target market

The features of this product have been assessed as meeting the likely objectives, financial situation and needs of consumers who:

- Are:
 - o at least 18 years old;
 - o individual borrowers (as single or joint borrowers); and
 - o an Australian citizen or a permanent Australian resident;
- Require a loan to purchase or refinance an owner-occupied property and who may also
 wish to release some of the equity in their property for other purposes such as to consolidate
 debt or to be used for personal or investment purposes;
- Require an offset account;
- Require the certainty of a fixed ljara rate;
- Are able to make up to \$20k of extra repayments without penalty; and
- Want the option of either principal and Ijara or Ijara only repayments.
- Satisfy our eligibility criteria;
 - o PAYG Last 2 payslips, 3 month banks statement & proof of genuine savings
 - Minimum employment criteria:
 - **Full Time** Minimum 6 months. If <6months, must have been in continuous employment in same industry for 12 months.
 - **Part time** same as above.
 - Second job Minimum 12 months in current employment.
 - Contract Same as full time with additional requirement of minimum 3 months remaining on contract.
 - Casual Minimum 12 months with current employment. Employment verification emphasized.
 - Self-employed -minimum 2 trading years in current business, most recent business tax return and financials and 2 most recent BAS (24 month ABN registration required).

The product meets the likely objectives, financial situation and needs of consumers in the target market because it provides them with the certainty of a fixed rate for an initial period of time, allows them to deposit funds into an offset account and/or make additional payments directly into the loan to reduce the amount of Ijara payable up to \$20k additional per annum whilst maintaining the ability to draw on surplus funds when required. This product also allows consumers to select Ijara only or principal and Ijara repayments in order to reduce their overall debt and build equity.



5.2 Classes of consumers for who the product may not be suitable

This product may not be suitable for consumers who:

- Do not meet the eligibility requirements;
- Are looking to construct a property; or
- Require the ability to provide alternative methods of income verification.

5.3 Description of the Product, including key attributes

- Fixed Ijara rate;
- Repayment options:
 - o principle and Ijara; or
 - o ljara only
- Redraw available
- Able to make up to \$20k of extra repayments without penalty
- Minimum loan size: \$50,000
- Maximum Loan Size: \$2,000,000 (subject to LVR and postcode policy)
- Maximum LVR:
 - o 80% for Inner-City postcodes
 - o 90% for Regional postcodes
 - o 95% for Metro and Non-Metro postcodes
- Offset facility available for a fee
- Application fee is payable
- Establishment fee is payable
- Settlement fee is payable
- Valuation fee is payable
- Ongoing fee is payable



6. Distribution Conditions/ Restrictions

The following distribution channels and conditions have been assessed as being appropriate to direct the distribution of the product to the target market:

- Direct
 - o Online
 - o By phone
 - o In person (e.g. branch, agency, or premises visit)
- Third party Accredited mortgage brokers subject to Best Ijaras Duty (BID)

The distribution channels and conditions are appropriate because:

- The product has a wide target market;
- Our staff have the necessary training, knowledge and accreditation (if required) to assess whether the consumer is within the target market. All of our staff must continually satisfy annual compliance reviews.
- We rely on existing distributors, methods, controls and supervision already in place;
- Our approval system has checks and controls in place to flag applicants who may be outside the target market; and
- Accredited mortgage brokers are subject to a higher duty under BID to ensure that the product is in the best ljaras of the particular consumer.
